

## Annexure E

### Arena Eventing

Arena Eventing is a two phase competition

Competitors first complete a round of show jumps, immediately followed by the cross country elements, situated inside or outside the showjumping arena and will finish with the last jump as a show jump, the joker fence.

The joker fence will be approximately 10 cm higher than the rest of the course. If the joker fence is knocked down, you will incur 6 penalties.

The optimum time will be based on a speed of 375m per minute as agreed with the course designer depending upon the size and terrain of the arena.

There will be no more than 20 jumping efforts in total (at least 50% must be cross country jumps)

The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties.

Time allowed is twice the optimum time.

Stopwatches are not permitted

The dimensions of the cross country fences will be according to the level in which the rider competes.

The show jumping fences will be 5 (five) cm higher than the cross country fences

In the event of a tie, clear rounds take precedence over time.

Penalties will be awarded as follows:

Every commenced second in excess optimum time	0.4 penalties	0.4 penalties
Exceeding time limit*	Elimination	Elimination
Error of course	Elimination	Elimination
Retaking obstacle already jumped	Elimination	Elimination

Grading: A clear round in Arena Eventing counts as ½ Qualifying result (QR). See NAMEF rules 5.2.3.2

That means, 2 clear Arena eventing rounds substitute one Qualifying round in a full eventing event.

**Ground Jury requirements for hosting a graded Arena Eventing event:-**

1 National/NAMEF Technical Delegate(TD)

1 Level 1 or 2 Show Jumping judge

1 Applicant Show Jumping judge and 1 scribe

1 Level 3 Show Jumping Course Designer or 1 XCCD National Course Designer

Fence Judges as required to man the fences

Registered Ambulance as per NAMEF R&R
