RULES & REGULATIONS:

NOTES:

1. The NAMEF 12th edition Rules, NAEMF Constitution and FEI rules shall apply,
2. Telephonic entries or entries unaccompanied by the correct or full entry fees will NOT be accepted! Late entries will be accepted but will not appear in the Program.
3. All Graded Competitions are open to full members of NAMEF, or another National Federation affiliated to FEI. This is a licensed event, for all Ungraded competition, please refer to rule 3.3.3.10 – only the horse must be registered.
4. For minimum age groups for Eventing, please refer to the NAMEF rules: 3.7
5. Horses competing in the show and RGO horses have preference in stable allocations above non-participating horses from outside Otjiwarongo.
6. NO shavings may be taken from the shaving bay.
7. Horse trailers and trucks may only be parked at areas designated by the Organizing Committee. No Trailor and/or truck may be parked between stables.
8. Camping only allowed within designated areas. Grooms may stay in trailers/horseboxes.
9. The Organizers reserve the right to
 - a) Cancel, combine/split and restrict competitions,
 - b) Amend the time schedule mentioned in the program & schedule.
 - c) Change the starting order of riders and their horses if required,
 - d) Postpone or cancel the show in part or totally, in case of unforeseen and/or special circumstances.
10. All horses must be accompanied by their updated Horse Passports, which must be handed in before starting (see provisional timetable).
11. **All Dogs must be always on leads.**
12. Catering will be available.

Neither NAMEF or the RGO, its officials or representatives as well as the organizers shall in any way or form be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by horses, riders, the public or their property at the show, caused by, or resulting from this tournament.

NOTES ON EV CLASSES:

- 1 Surcingle are highly recommended.
- 2 Competitors, please note that medical cards are compulsory and must be clearly visible on the rider, preferably on the arm of the athlete.
- 3 BIB Numbers are to be collected at the riders Briefing. They are to be worn for the Cross Country Test.
- 4 **CHANGES BETWEEN CLASSES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES. HORSES MAY ONLY START IN ONE CLASS.**
- 5 Ponies/horses may compete from the 1st of January of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 4 years for Eventing 80. Riders who are in 70s get upgraded to 80s since there is no more 70s.
- 6 **As from Monday, the 6th of June 2022, no competitor/competing horse may ride in the vicinity of the cross-country obstacles. The Cross-Country Track will be closed from as 6th of June 2022 at 07h30.**
- 7 The Cross-Country courses will be open for inspection on foot from 17h00 Friday, 10th June 2022. This is regarded as the official starting time of the event so all Eventing
