

# LITTLE HORSE SHOE 3 (Gold)

## Syllabus

### A. First Aid for horse and rider

- measuring the temperature
- cleaning and dressing of small wounds
- treatment of lameness
- behavior in case of emergency
- what to do in case of a fall or accident

### B. Preparation for a show

1. Entering for a show
  - a. Procedure of entering for a show
  - b. Preparations for transporting and stabling the horse at a foreign stable
2. Preparation of the horse
  - a. Trimming of fetlocks, tail, mane and ears
  - b. Brushing of coat, tail and mane
  - c. Plaiting of the tail and mane
3. Preparation of the rider
  - a. Tidiness of tack
  - b. Riders attire
    - i. Rules of outfit for various events (hairnet, shirt, jacket, boots/chaps, pants etc)

### C. Rules and Regulations

1. Responsibilities of a rider at a show (horse comes first)
2. Rules when riding in an arena (ribbons in tails, how to ride with many horses around)
  - a. Rules of warmup arena
    - i. How to pass another horse
    - ii. How to approach a jump
  - b. Rules of the dressage arena
    - i. Sizes of arena
    - ii. Letters of arena
    - iii. Knowledge of the dressage figures
    - iv. Greeting of the judge

- c. Rules in the jumping arena
  - i. Knowledge of the various elements of a course (ringing of the bell, start, course, flags, finish)
  - ii. Knowledge of the basic jump types (vertical, oxer, triple bar...)
  - iii. Behaviour of rider in arena when
    - 1. Walking the course
    - 2. In the arena while other competitor is riding
    - 3. Greeting/approaching the judges
    - 4. Horse refuses
    - 5. Rider wants to give up
    - 6. Rider is included in prize giving
    - 7. Riding a parade

- 3. Ability to ride a Lollipop dressage test
- 4. Ability to jump a 60 cm course
