## NAMEF YELLOW CARD

AS PER NAMEF RULES AND REGULATIONS ARTICLE 1.15

OFFICIAL MAY DELIVER TO THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE A YELLOW WARNING CARD,  
EITHER BY HAND OR BY ANY OTHER SUITABLE MEANS.

In the first instance it should be accepted as a **warning**.

A Yellow card can be presented to the following people at an equestrian event:

- Any member of NAMEF, e.g. any rider
- Any parent, guardian, trainer or coach of a rider. In this case the recipient of the yellow card will be related to the rider (NAMEF member).
- A judge, official, spectator or any other person present on an equestrian event.

**Appeal: 1.15.10.7**

The recipient of a yellow card has the right to appeal in writing to the show organiser within 1 hour after receipt of the yellow card, together with a deposit fee as determined by NAMEF. Ref to Art. 1.15
